

*If the following is acceptable to the University, the University shall have this Agreement signed in duplicate by a duly authorized representative of the University and a professor or a supervisor of the Student in the University and submit one (1) signed original to KU.*

## **Agreement**

     [Name of University] (“**University**”), having approved that the student of it      [Name of Student] (“**Student**”) participates in CiRA Research Internship Program hosting by Center for iPS Cell Research and Application (“**CiRA**”) in Kyoto University (“**KU**”)      from MM/DD/YYYY to MM/DD/YYYY (“**Program**”) and performs research activities (“**Research Activities**”), agrees the following terms and conditions for his/her participation in the Program;

1. The University agrees the following conditions, and ensures that the Student will comply with them and sign “Agreement for CiRA Research Internship Program”.
  - 1) The Student shall follow his/her host researcher’s instruction at any time.
  - 2) Handling of inventions and materials created or discovered by the Student through the Research Activities is subject to KU’s internal regulations. In compliance with KU internal regulations for prevention of misconducts in the Research Activities in KU, the Student shall not fabricate data, falsify research results, disclose and/or use any idea, research process, and/or research results that he/she may be informed of from other researcher(s) to anybody else without permission of the other researcher(s), and do not act against researcher’s ethics.
  - 3) Any information that the Student may access to during the Research Activities shall NOT be:
    - a) used for any other purpose except the Research Activities in KU without prior permission of KU before such Information becomes in the public domain and;
    - b) disclosed and/or leaked to any third parties (including but not limited to other researchers and students in the University) without prior permission of KU before such Information becomes in the public domain.
  - 4) Upon termination of the Program or upon request of KU, at KU’s direction, the Student shall return or destroy all confidential information retained in any form, including but not limited to, electronic media, hard copies and the duplicated papers, which are disclosed, made available or accessible by KU to the Student during the Program.
  - 5) The Student shall carry out the Research Activities in compliance with all applicable laws, statues, codes of practice or regulations, for example, those relating to research involving the use of animals or recombinant DNA or the ethical conduct of scientific research. The

Student shall observe all rules, regulations and requirements of CiRA, KU, including but not limited to confidentiality, safety, and health.

- 6) KU will own any findings in any form, including without limitation, records of work or tangible research results generated by the Student during the Program, as well as resulting patent application or patent covering the same if determined by KU.
  - 7) No tangible research material (including but not limited to materials generated by the Student through the Research Activities) will be;
    - a) released or taken out of the research space of KU without prior written approval from KU; and
    - b) used for any other purpose except the Research Activities in KU.
  - 8) The Student must pay the tuition set by KU for the agreed period of study.
2. The Program and/or the Research Activities are understood to be experimental in nature. KU takes the safety measures according to its internal rules to its facilities and research environment where the Program and the Research Activities are carried out. KU makes no other representations or warranties of any kind, including without limitations, any warranty of fitness for a particular purpose thereof, the quality thereof (including the accuracy, usefulness, correctness or harmlessness of the performance thereof), the non-toxicity or safety thereof, the non-existence of any defect therein, or non-infringement.
  3. KU, and their directors, officers, employees and agents shall not be liable for any loss, claim, damage, or liability of any kind (including death, injury, or illness) involving the University, the Student or its/his/her property in the course of, arising out of or in connection with the Program and/or the Research Activities except to the extent that it is directly due to the gross negligence or willful misconduct of any of the directors, officers, employees or agents of KU.  
The University ensure that the Student has insurance that covers liability, accidents, illness, etc, whether they occur outside or inside of KU, during the period of his/her stay for the Program by the time the Program starts.
  4. No rights or licenses to patent rights, copyrights, trademarks or other intellectual property rights are assigned or granted, explicitly, implicitly or otherwise, by KU to the University under or pursuant to this agreement or the Student's participation in this Program.
  5. Paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall survive termination of the Program.
