Consideration will also be given to those who can apply the research to personalized medicine, drug discovery, regenerative medicine with a focus on iPS cell stock, etc., by utilizing iPSC technology as effective tools and developing new tools. Job requirements	<p>Candidates should have a doctoral degree (of medicine, dentistry, pharmacology, science or technology) or equivalent professional achievements. They should also have adequate research or business achievements that demonstrate the ability to supervise a research team as a principal investigator. Experience with iPS cell research is not required.
